If you don't attend school regularly, you may:



















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












 What if you can't come to school?

 else stopping you from attending, such as a family funeral. Your parents must make















 sure you go to school if you are well.

 We keep an eye on your attendance and look out for any concerns.

























 We are responsible for your safety and well-being whilst at school.
